He Will Guide You Into All Truth

Editor's Note: The following came after a brief explanation about God using exhortation as a means to deliver what is needed or to bring understanding.

In the days of the apostles and the formation of the New Testament, these had the Word of God inside. Paul speaking: "I thank my God I pray"—speak in tongues—"more than you all," because he had already pegged it as a source, on-purpose source to receive the mysteries of God that were hid in Christ Jesus—the mystery of who Christ is in you, the Hope of glory.

Paul knew he couldn't pray in this language that came down from Heaven and not [be] praying those mysteries out for the purpose of them being answered in a form of understanding the mysteries he was praying out. Remember, their letters explaining these mysteries are now your Scriptures in the New Testament.

They had to walk out here [to teach] armed with what they knew and having been taught by the Holy Spirit through this one major avenue in particular—praying in the Holy Ghost. For Jesus mentioned Him when He said, For He—the Holy Spirit—shall receive of Mine and show it unto you. He will not push drag or pull, but He will guide you into all truth.
