One Word Will Change You

As I was preparing this message, I was hearing this and I wrote down what I heard: There are some of you, you need to focus on one word until it becomes bone of your bone. For some of you, it would be, "You are forgiven." You are forgiven. That needs to become so you, and when it does, you are going to be a changed person. You are forgiven. Another one is where He says to you, "I will remember your sins no more." That one word will change you.

I have been giving testimonies about this one, this word—it's Matthew six: "I will provide for you." If you put His Kingdom first and seek His righteousness first, you have it in the red letters—"all these things will be added."

We have to develop that kind of attitude with Him.
