He Is Grateful for Willingness to Trust Him

I hear Him say He has been searching for a people who would be willing to follow Him into a place of revival, and I hear Him say from His heart: He is grateful. He is grateful for a people who trust Him so much to go beyond their natural eyes and see the riches that He holds of value instead of the riches that the world sees as value. He is just grateful.

There is a gratefulness in His voice to me of your willingness to trust Him, and the Lord says, to see His riches, what He sees as riches, and to place His value on that. The world doesn't place value on the riches of God of what He sees as valuable. And for you and I to follow Him with a trust that doesn't reward us now is a faith, is a trust to say, "God, I am willing to follow You and put honor to what You put honor to, to put value onto what You put value to."

See, go to a prison and find a lost guy there, and the world doesn't see value to him. They've got to lock that guy up, but God, He sees value on that guy in prison and is appreciative of someone willing to go and preach to him.
