Midnight Hour

There will be shared a lot of oil in the midnight prayer, because there is coming midnight for the life of many. Things will not continue the way they used to be. There is change coming, but it is a blessing for all those who pray and those who hear the voice of the Spirit. They will be able to say, "I saw it coming. I saw it coming. I heard about this before, and I am well prepared. My jar is full with oil, oil of the Holy Ghost, oil that is burning in the midnight hour." So all of you who know how to pray, be happy and be glad. This is your day.

Everything you have been trained for and you have heard and have seen—you will be used in this hour. And there are new people starting to pray, because they are hearing the sound, while others are fainting away and getting tired and choose another way. But the way of prayer has always been the high way into all that I have for you, and that will never change.

So it is midnight hour for the lives of many, but remember what happened at midnight: Salvation came to those in jail. Salvation came to those in jail, and the chains of bondage were broken. So rejoice and be glad that you learned how to pray. And there will be a pathway for many—you prayed for the path, and many will follow. And in this day and in this hour, the knowledge of how to pray will be of more worth than gold and silver and anything that you could name. So rejoice, rejoice, rejoice, and be happy.

This is the midnight cry. The Bridegroom is calling his bride, and the sound is going out, for He is coming, He is coming back into His house with everything that He is—all His power and all His holiness and all the judgment. So you are glad if you judge yourself already and if you consider your ways and you stay humble. And I tell you again that I will take you to places that are much different than what you ever thought. Behold the Lamb of God. Behold the Lamb of God. You have seen Him in His majesty, and you have seen Him on the Cross, and you know who He really is, and that sets you free. So be encouraged. Those of little faith, be encouraged. Just continue to move forward and all will be well.

**Matthew 25:1-10** Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom. 2 And five of them were wise, and five were foolish. 3 They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them: 4 But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. 5 While

the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. 6 And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him. 7 Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. 8 And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. 9 But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves. 10 And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut.
