The Anointing Coming Out of Your Praise and Worship

If you could see into the realm of the Spirit the way that I see into the realm of the Spirit and see what has taken place this morning during your praise and your worship, you would have seen a great cleansing taking place. You would have seen a tremendous amount of realignment taking place in the hearts of many people. You would have seen restoration taking place in those who have come here seeking for restoration. You would have seen chains of bondage being broken because of the anointing released during this praise and worship. You would have seen how that you through your praise and worship were ministering to those around you because of the anointing coming out of your praise and worship. For I have said in My Word that I inhabit your praises, and therefore, since I inhabit your praises, My anointing inhabits those praises as well. And as you praise Me and as you worship Me, My anointing is being released through you in that praise and worship to not only minister to you but to those who are around you.

If you could have seen what was happening in the realm of the Spirit as you praised and worshiped Me, you would have seen a glory released that blinds the eyes of the enemy.
