Paper Walls

I saw a large sheet of paper being easily torn from the top to the bottom. I then saw a room with paper walls, and as I looked around, all I could see were the paper walls. As I was looking at these walls, I saw the curtain at the Holy of Holies in the temple being torn from the top to the bottom, and I heard these words: “You can tear the paper of these walls easily now.”

I didn't speak but asked what to do to tear these walls down, and I heard: “Continue to obey what I have told you to do.” Immediately, I knew He referred to one specific thing for me, and I knew that I was to continue to do as He said about this one specific prayer. I was to continue to speak a specific scripture that was changing from confession, to promise, to prophecy, to completed manifestation of a part of the Kingdom of God on the earth.

He said, “I have given those here [all those who are part of The Family Prayer Center] specific instructions, but some have forgotten them or did not consider them important, and they became lost in all the other things they have done. Matthew 22:1-9 And Jesus answered and spake unto them again by parables, and said, 2 The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son, 3 And sent forth his servants to call them that were bidden to the wedding: and they would not come. 4 Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready: come unto the marriage. 5 But they made light of it, and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise: 6 And the remnant took his servants, and entreated them spitefully, and slew them. 7 But when the king heard thereof, he was wroth: and he sent forth his armies, and destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city. 8 Then saith he to his servants, The wedding is ready, but they which were bidden were not worthy. 9 Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage.
