### Be Obedient—You Will Move Forward Quickly

To many, I say: Come and be obedient. For you walked around and around and around and around the mountain of the one thing that I have asked you to do, and I will never change. I will not change. My instructions cannot change. I will walk with you and walk with you and walk with you, but you will not progress with Me unless you obey what I have told you. There is no other way. So listen to Me. Listen to Me: Trust that I know what I am telling you, and it is for a reason.
