### I Have Pruned the Root to the Core

Note these things, says the Spirit of the Lord, and see if they do not come to pass in your lifetime. Note these things and judge even the one who is saying these things, whether he is false or true. Know this: The days are coming, and not far from this time, when the glory and the Presence that one brought, many will bring, says the Spirit of Grace. The saturation of His glory that I brought through a few will be placed on many, says the Spirit of Grace. And what has seemed like, at times, even a dry season, know this, that this was not a dry season for you.

My Presence has never left, from even in what you would call the glory days. For some would speak in their heart and even with their mouth, "I long for those kinds of services when His glory fell and His Presence was so tangible." But know this: This is not a backsliding. This is not something that Satan or the flesh has brought into fruition, but I have pruned the root back all the way to the core, says the Spirit of Grace, that I could bring it forth as a green tree in a dry and thirsty land.

For have I not said that you are plantings of the Lord, trees of life? I'll bring you forth in these last days, not that one would glory—that many would glory in My Presence. And that not one would carry My Presence—that many plantings would come into the fullness of what they have been planted for, says the Spirit of the Lord.

For the days will come in this house [church] when not a seat will not be taken. Many will stand up against the walls and crowd the places and crowd the altars. And you will see services like you have never seen before. Now is as you have heard others speak and affirm My Word—now is the time for the laying and the continuation of soundness of doctrine. But know this: As tough as it would seem to you in the Spirit that I am, at times, in training you, know this, that on the other side of that is more than an equal outpouring of My glory and of My Presence—so strong that you will not be able to stand in the house.

Not one will lead, but many will lead, because of the Presence that I will place upon them and what they are doing in this time of pruning, says the Spirit of Grace. One part of this house [church], this physical location, while some are being healed, others in the other part of the auditorium will be delivered and set free. Glory will fall, Presence will come, and all will be kept in order for these last days.

A Presence and a sweeping of My Presence is coming into this house [church]. Know: This season is just as valuable as any season that you have ever faced or thought glorious in the past, says the Spirit of Grace.

Live in great hope, for these are not words to tickle the ear nor to encourage the heart nor to end the conference, says the Spirit of Grace, but these words will come to pass in the days ahead. That which has seemed like a dry and thirsty land will begin to be again a river of life. That which was pruned back in the Spirit and even in numeric [quantity], know that it will change. It will change, and you will be glad in those hours that you did not resist the pruning, but you stepped into it.
