Count as Dear Your Words Spoken

My earnest desire is a praying people, a yielded people. A praying church is the work of fellowship with Me, and it is of utmost importance to pray for those in leadership in the land that you might live godly and peaceable lives. This does not mean that prayer will bring forth blissful life on this earth, but it does mean that I will be given inroads in men and women's lives so that avenues are held open to Me, to My Spirit. My words are words from the fountain of life that is within.

The charge which has been given is to first of all pray for those who are in authority, not based on agreement or disagreement, like or dislike. The more those in My Body rise up in obedience to this, the more compassion will flow and the more authority that will be released for My Spirit to bring forth the will of the Kingdom. This nation and all nations need the authority that is released through the prayers of My own so that I might move by My Spirit.

The enemy has been free to move in too many situations because of a lack of prayer and proper words from My people. Many have been speaking without judging their own words and ways. Words of criticism, judgmental words being spoken—this should not be. Faith calls those things that be not as though they were, and critical words and judgmental words are not of the spirit of faith.

I say as One who is Faithful and your Father: Judge your words, judge your hearts, and make adjustments toward Me. You are not as those who are of strife and turmoil, those who loosely speak. You are lights shining in the darkness. Be mouthpieces of truth, life, and peace. Criticism in the heart of man is the evidence of pride, and this is a self-exaltation that I am purging in this hour in all who are intent on these things.

There are things I desire to do in the midst of the darkness that is encroaching upon many lands. The heart of faith believes and speaks the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things which are not yet seen. I am building an army of those who are

rising into the stature of the image of Christ, diminished in no way from the Image that is revealed in My Word of the One who spoke My words and yielded His words to Me.

Give place to My Spirit of Grace. Give place to My ways. Give place to Me. Those who desire to finish strong will adhere to these things. As a faithful Father I speak, for many hearts are yearning to enter all the way into places in Me where revival life is the normal manner of living.

Dearly beloved, guard your hearts with all diligence, taking heed to that which I speak. These are the days, as are the days coming, when that which you speak is what you hear Me speak and that which you say is that which I would have you to say. Let the purging continue and count as dear that which I speak. Count as dear your words that are spoken as My kings and priests, for these are your finest hours even in the purging, just as your finest hours are yet ahead in Me.
