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There Has to Be a Healing and a Restoration

He wants to heal us. We've endured a long time. There's been a lot of pain, a lot of hurt, a lot of heartache. And in order to fight the war, many times we had to ignore those things, and we had to press in by His Spirit and push past those things. But He said the scars and the hurt, it never really went away. We just pushed past it.

He is saying He wants to heal those hurts. He is beginning something that is going to be restoration. He is beginning to heal some hurts of the past, and we will go through a season—maybe seasons—of healing and restoration, because He is bringing forth an army and we will see miracles outside of this place. But to see the miracles to those that are outside, there has to be a healing and a restoration inside.

And He wants as much [for] us to walk in the fullness of God as He wants to flow that fullness through us. And sometimes we can be so consumed in [desires for] seeing revival and wanting revival and seeing the miracles flow through us that we forget to receive it for ourselves. We don't realize—we look past all of the hurts, all of the inabilities, all of the problems that we have and we say "Well, it's worth it for the Gospel." But God says you don't have to live with it.

You don't have to carry the pain, you don't have to carry the hurt, you don't have to carry the inabilities any longer. Because I love you as much as I love the people I am trying to reach through you.
