I Am Making Room for More of Me

I am bringing a correction to those who will hear and those who will receive of My Spirit. It is not a correction by word nor by man, but it is a correction by My Spirit that I am bringing to those who will listen and receive from Me, because there are adjustments that must be made in the hearts of man in order for Me to advance this body into what I have planned.

So I am saying to you this day: Listen. Listen in your spirit. Listen in the private times and places, and open up those areas in your heart that you have kept private and said, “These are things that I do. This is my time. These are the things that God doesn’t bother me about.”

He says, Bring those things to Me, for some have said, “Yeah, for that person they must stop doing that, and for this person they must do that.” But I say for each and every one, I am making adjustments and changing things within you. So do not have the attitude that I would not touch these things in your life, but bring them to Me.

I am not going to force your hand. I am not going to demand those things from you, but I am asking you to bring them freely to Me—the things in your life that you own, the time that you own, the pleasures and entertainment that you own. If you will bring that to Me, let Me judge it and allow Me to say, continue in this or do not continue in this.

In order to advance in My Spirit, there is a responsibility and a requirement that I am bringing upon those who want to go. And in this level, it is going to mean bringing everything to Me. Those places in the soul that you thought were just fun and enjoyable and have been—I want that. Bring it to Me.

I will give you fun, I will give you joy. I will give you peace. But I am requiring all of you, all of you. Do not have the attitude, “He wouldn’t take this away from me,” because number one, I am not taking it from you. I am making room for more of Me.
