## **Present-Day Speaking**

### **‘You Are the One I Am Waiting For’**

1. I came for the heart of man, and My desire is our fellowship each day. I know the ins and outs of your struggles, and I alone know how to reach into every detail and help you see into who you are in Me today. Your place in Me is a heavenly seat and a position of great authority and great peace.

2. I am Love—I am your Father. I reach into every heart who gives himself to Me, and I reveal who I am in ever increasing degrees. Knowing the heart of the Father is knowing Love, and in this is the knowing and understanding of My heart for you and My heart for man. This is the key to everything and is a key to the wisdom found in Me.

3. The Father’s love is the love that is the same yesterday, today, and forever. This love cannot be earned. It is only to be received, for it is free and limitless—without limits. This love heals. This love restores. This love cleanses. This love delivers. This love speaks. This love reaches beyond the depths of every fault, every flaw, every frailty, and weakness, and beyond the sins that are hidden from the eyes of men and says, “Come. Come.”

4. I see you who want more of Me yet feel unworthy. You approach Me based on behavior and see yourself through your weaknesses and to draw near to Me brings you face to face with thoughts and feelings about these things. In your eyes, you see yourself unworthy, for your faults and failings are what you think you are presenting to Me. Approach Me based on My unconditional love for you.

5. My love is not based on your performance—My love is based on Me. I love you because I love you, says the Lord. Receive it; receive My love, says the Lord.

6. You are coming to Me as one of My own, a cherished member of My family. You are coming to Me because I am your Strength. I am the One who helps you and walks with you into the changes you need and into restoration and greater freedom. And it is in My Presence where many of these things are received. Come to Me based on who I am to you. I am your Father who loves you, helps you, and teaches you in the way you should go.

7. Learn to keep coming even when you feel most unworthy. Be mindful of this one thing: You are the one I am waiting for—I am Your Father, and I am the One who has the help and strength you need for every step of your life in Me. Come, for I

always draw near to the one who draws near to Me. Faithful I am, and Faithful is all I will ever be.

8. There is nothing I will not do for you. There is nothing I will not do for you, says the Lord. Those who will walk with Me, love Me, and have fellowship with Me, learn of Me, and just spend time with Me and get to know Me, there is nothing I will not do for you. And all of Heaven and all of the Father's resources belong to you. You are My joint heir, says the Lord, and all that the Father has is yours, because all that the Father has is Mine. There is nothing I will not do for you, says the Lord.

9. I do not love you for your works, your performance. I love you because you are born of My Spirit and made in My own image. You are Mine—you are a member of My household.

10. Unworthiness tells you that you are not as good as someone else or shows you your failings or your weaknesses, but don't you know that I see you, and you are the one whom I love? I will not reject you. Come closer. Come closer in your worship. Come closer in your heart to Me, and I will prove to you that I love you.

11. Your place in Me in My family comes by the grace that you are free to receive. There is no act or good thing you can do to receive. Just believe—that is the entrance into all I have provided.

12. All of My love, I give to each one, and of this love, there is no end. I give each one full inheritance, and I give each one My undivided attention. I am earnestly attentive to even the slightest whisper in the heart. I see all things and know all things, and I am merciful even when mercy seems not to fit, for I know every thought and the intent of every heart. My mercies fail not.

13. Many think I draw a line in My love that is based on their strengths and weaknesses, and they see this line moving them closer to Me in their strengths and moving them farther away from My love in their weaknesses. But this is not how I am. I give you My love and the fullness of My love when you are weak and when you are strong.

14. The faithfulness of My love never changes. The sincerity of My love remains the same. Who I was yesterday is who I am today and who I will be for all eternity. There is no changing with Me. I am a place of rest and safety and a constant love indeed.

15. I am reaching out to you and drawing you to Me—come. Come with the wisdom that, as you come, you are coming to lose more of you so that you will walk in more of Me. Come with the knowing that in these times of Me drawing you, each time you come, you are surrendering your life and allowing Me to be the Captor of your heart. There is a strong grace involved in this heart capturing that is taking place. Each one who gives in to the drawing toward Me that is taking place will find that I have taken more of you and given you more of Me. This is the surrender that is true—it always results in change and more of My life in you.

### **Know Your Significance**

I have birthed you for a sole purpose, and yet you hardly know your significance. Do not let the flesh or the mundane blind you. “I know me. I know me,” says self unto you—“I know me; I’m just me.” But I say unto you that you are My son, My daughter, My high priest who is to bring forth the high praises and the intercession in the earth that will bring forth the great and last-day harvest of My Kingdom, says the Spirit of Grace. For you’ve not expected more of yourself as you should. But expect far more of yourself in going forward.

Put a higher mark to your life and expect yourself to be in a place with Me that can turn the city and that can turn the nation, says the Spirit of Grace. When you think of smaller terms of yourself, you minimize My ability to flow through you in authority and expectation of things in faith that will truly turn a city upside down, says the Spirit of the Lord.

When you relate to yourself as you would relate to a friend with many faults and do not see the higher part of you which is called up into higher places to make intercession for the city, when you live out of the familiar, then you demoralize and bring low the place of authority that is in you that I have placed to bring forth the revival, says the Spirit of Grace.

There is a pride that can exist out of the flesh, and too many guard themselves at the expense of the Spirit saying, “I will not pride myself over there,” but yet in the same way, you’ll not live out of that place of authority by familiarizing yourself with the flesh. But you must, you must come up higher, expect more, and do more, and be more for Me, for that place of authority, says the Spirit of Grace.
