Present-Day Speaking **‘Look to the Horizon—Change Can Already Be Seen’**

1. You Are Free to Enjoy Your Father

You are free to enjoy your Father the moment you become His child. You are free to experience His love, His joy about you, His excitement about you every moment of every day. When you think He is offended, you will find that He is proud.

Zephaniah 3:17 The Lord your God in your midst, the Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing.

2. I Will Not Pull Back My Hand

Know your Father loves you. And know that this love is unchanging and does not originate in you—Love is who I am. My love is extended to you and I will **NOT** pull back My hand. I reach for you to come. Come into the knowledge of who I am through the fellowship of My Spirit and see things from where I stand.
