Dear Friend,

Sometimes one of the biggest challenges we face as believers is not always the most obvious. Where many of us suffer defeat is in thinking our “mountain” is the circumstances we face, when in reality, the mountain is usually what we believe about our circumstances.

However, as we continue to spend time in the Word, praying in the Spirit, speaking God’s Word, and getting to know Him more intimately through our private times of fellowship with Him, we are doing those things the Lord has taught us to enable us to grow and mature in the knowledge of Him. We become doers of His Word as we do these things.

When the pressures of life come and feelings of helplessness move in, we can lose sight of one of the most powerful principles of faith—**CORRESPONDING ACTIONS!** This is why Jesus compared faith to a mustard seed.

A mustard seed is very small, but the plant that seed produces is much larger than what our natural mind might think a little seed could ever produce. And in the same way, to our natural mind, it could seem to us a waste of time to keep digging away at our mountain one spoonful at a time. Yet, as we learn and grow in the understanding of faith, we begin to realize that it is not the amount of dirt each spoonful removes that makes the difference. The difference is the faith that it takes to stand there and keep digging away at the mountain.

The mountains of perceptions that influence us with uncertainties concerning God’s Word and the circumstances we face, doubts about our ability to change, doubts about whom the Word says we are—no matter what, as we keep removing “spoonful’s of dirt” through our fellowship with the Lord, the spoonful’s will become bigger and bigger chunks being removed from that mountain of doubt and uncertainty, all because we have chosen to be doers of what God has said.

To have the kind of faith that changes the facts and removes the mountains we face about those facts, we need to understand the kind of actions we are to take that actually correspond with faith.

Let’s look at Mark 11:23, which says: **For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.**

Corresponding actions are what help a believer come to the place where he **DOUBTS NOT IN HIS HEART**. Because it is when a person doubts not in his heart that he will have what he says. Therefore, when he speaks to the mountain to go, it goes!

The kind of corresponding actions we need to take have everything to do with our fellowship with God—praying in the supernatural language of tongues, praising and worshiping God, meditating and assimilating and confessing the Word as well

as personal words He has spoken to us, spending time fasting, waiting on God in His Presence, and co-laboring with the Holy Spirit in obedience to the Word and His personal instructions to us. These are some major spiritual keys to use to bring permanent change to our heart and to what we believe.

When a person is discouraged or in a seemingly hopeless situation, when the mountain he is facing looks too big to be moved in the natural, no matter how hard he tries, plans, or begs, there is hope!

Hebrews 4:11 says: **Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.** The reason a man falls is because he has no place of rest—no place of peace, confidence, or trust in God. Unrest is the opposite of faith, so if a man has rest—peace, confidence, trust in God—he has faith.

Therefore, our corresponding actions of faith, or our “labours” as Hebrews 4:11 says, should be using the spiritual keys—**DOING** the Word—that bring us to a place of rest from which our mountain-moving faith can operate.

Laboring or striving against the mountains in our life solely by the natural realm only produces natural results—if that. Yet, as citizens of God’s Kingdom, we are to strive and labor to enter into the rest and assurance He has provided for us which are available as we fellowship with Him. You see, we cannot be doers of the Word without fellowshiping with God.

Each day as we enter into God’s Presence to spend time with Him, we are digging away at those mountains in our life, even if it feels like it’s one spoonful at a time. As we pray in the Spirit, we are building ourselves up on our most holy faith, and we are learning to believe in our heart so that we can rest in Him and have peace and confidence in Him that His Word and every word He has spoken to us are true. And as faith grows within us—like the tiny mustard seed that grows into a beautiful plant—we will speak to the mountain, and it will be removed.

The enemy comes with circumstances designed to steal, kill, and destroy, but when those circumstances come, we can react by taking time in God’s Presence and building ourselves up by praying in tongues: **He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself** (First Corinthians 14:4a). We can look for scriptures and for our personal words we’ve received from God that most accurately describe our victory in the situations. We can renew our mind to truth by turning these words into personal confessions that we regularly speak concerning ourselves and the situations.

A powerful tool the Lord has been reminding us of is worship. We can worship the Lord concerning what He has promised us and let the truth of His Word and His Presence drive out fear and negative emotions that are contrary to the peace and rest that are ours in Him.

Our spiritual actions of faith, being doers of the Word, help replace the images of failure, hopelessness, and despair in our soul with images painted by the Word and the peace of God.

Regardless of how big the mountains seem to be that you are standing in the shadow of or how long those mountains have been there, through your fellowship with God, you can enter into a place of rest where even though you can feel the mountains with your fingers, even though you can see the mountains with your eyes, and even though thoughts of mountains try to take over your emotions, you will be able to stand in the place of victory with your Father knowing how much He loves you, how much He is for you, and that above all, His Word is true and you can trust Him to help you defeat every single mountain!

## **Present-Day Speaking 'Be a Doer of the Word'**

### **He Who Is a Doer of My Word**

In My peace is prosperity, in My peace is power, in My peace is the stability that causes things to come to pass. Oh hear, hear and listen, for he who is a doer of My Word and not a hearer only is he who comes into this place—it is he who will conform to My Image from glory to glory. Hear what the Spirit would say and come, for the journey that pleases Me is this journey of peace as you let go of those things that cause you turmoil and embrace those things that give you peace.

**2 Corinthians 3:18** But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

### **There Is No Age in Me**

There is no age in Me, says the Lord, and there is no time, for it is by My grace that things are obtained. And one will take longer, and one will take shorter, but it is not by works. These things are obtained by grace. So why do you set your eyes on this one and that one? Set your eyes upon Me, says the Lord, and I will show you that it is by My grace. For why do you take time to study those who fall? Why don't you study those who succeed? For My grace is sufficient—whether a man stands or he falls, what does that have to do with you? Come, says the Lord, and follow Me, for this is all by grace, and your exaltation can come overnight. **James 1:22** But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

## **Take My Gospel Afresh**

Take My Gospel afresh like you have not heard it before. Take it like a child—for the first time hearing the best news that you have ever heard. For it is the best news you have ever heard, says the Lord. Receive it like a child. Receive it joyfully. Receive it just as it is said. Receive it just as it is written. Do not change it. Do not listen to those who would change it. Receive it, says the Lord, for it is truly yours. And I intend to even do exceedingly, abundantly above anything that you have asked Me for so far. Your eyes shall see it. Your hearts will rejoice, and it shall be sooner than you expect.

**1 Thessalonians 2:13** For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.

## **Take Heed and Pay Attention and Listen**

Pay attention to My truths which have been forever settled in Heaven and in earth. Take heed to the manner of doctrine that is being heard. Seat warmers [not being doers of the Word] get very few diplomas.

**2 Timothy 1:9** Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

## **Above All Cost, Be a Doer of My Word**

As you are obedient to continue on the narrow path, it will become clearly evident to you that every moment of every day is spent with eternity in mind. For My mind is that not one second of your day be spent on anything that does not contain eternal value. Surrender and ask Me to help you be a good steward of the time you have been gifted with.
