Dear Friend,

The Father's direction in us grows like a tree, and although the growth might seem slow at first, we just need to keep trusting Him as our Father and keep watering the seed of fellowship with Him by spending time in His Presence praying in tongues, reading and meditating on the Word, worshiping Him, resting in Him, and so on, and pretty soon, we'll have a full grown tree with fruit hanging on it. Why? Because the more time we spend with Him yielding to His desire for fellowship with us, the more we get to know, trust, and understand who He is, get to understand how much He really loves us, and that He is the Answer to all of our needs, questions, and circumstances.

"But I'm in a crisis situation now! I can't wait that long to know what to do!"

God knows all about the situations we're facing and He is present immediately with His grace and truth. However, sometimes there's a change in our life that needs to take place first, and in so doing, the true victory that Jesus made available for us can manifest.

Our Father loves to co-labor with us and provide the remedy for every problem. He especially loves to show us how to avoid problem areas before we encounter them. Therefore, a great deal of His leadership in our life deals with our obedience in taking the steps necessary for our spiritual growth and maturity, the mortification of the things in our soul that don't line up with His Word, our love walk with others, and so on.

None of us like to go through crises, but there are times in the life of every believer when storms come, sometimes bringing with them adverse circumstances outside of our control. Yet, even in the midst of difficult times, if we continue to water the seed of fellowship with our Father, His direction will grow inside our spirit, and what we receive in our spirit will be transferred over to our soul—and we'll know exactly what to do. Because He will cause His purposes, His desires, His plans for our life to come to pass every time. This is the fruit of a Spirit-led life, and it begins with us coming to Him as Father and allowing Him to be Father to us through His life within us.

As we spend much time watering the seed of fellowship with our Father, He is faithful to build beneath us a mighty foundation, and the Holy Spirit, our Helper, will go before us, working the Father's plans in our life and leading us through obstacles that would try to hinder. God's leadership will not only guide us into all truth but will also see to our continuing growth and maturity in Him as He walks with us every step of the way. He is a faithful Father, and He loves us.

### **Obedience to the Little Things**
