Dear Friend,

It is so important that we recognize and believe the eternal truth that God's love for us is not based on our performance, life choices, accomplishments, or mistakes. In fact, other than being the object of God's love, we have nothing at all to do with it. His love for us is based solely on who He is: He is God, and **God is love** (First John 4:8). He can't help but love, because Love is who He is.

In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that HE LOVED US, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

1 John 4:9,10

We know by Scriptures that God's eternal, unchanging love for us does not mean that He cannot be grieved with our behavior or that He will ever accept sin, for as much as He is Love, He is also Righteousness and Holiness and absolute Light. There is no darkness in Him at all, neither does He have communion with darkness. However, too many born-again sons and daughters of God look at their performance and think God loves them more when they do "good" and less when they do "bad."

Romans 5:8 says: **God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.** God does not love us any more today being His born-again children than He did when we were still lost and unsaved. The Bible says He sent Jesus after us while we were **STILL SINNERS**. The difference we experience now as His children is not more love, it is that we have been forgiven, redeemed, and brought back into His family by the blood, death, and resurrection of Jesus. That means, as members of God's family, we have God's very nature within us, the nature of Christ, by which we have been set free from sin—we are no longer trapped in sin. Within us, we have God's ability to grow in the truth and knowledge of how we can walk and live in Him. And we also have access to the Holy Spirit who has come as our Teacher to guide us into all truth and the way we should go. Therefore, as God's children, our Father expects us to learn to hear and submit to His nature witnessing on the inside of us and to learn to follow the Holy Spirit's leadership within us. He does not love us more today than before we were saved, but He does expect more from us now. His expectation is that we will come to Him as our Father and get to know Him and His heart toward us and allow His Holy Spirit to help us grow up in Him where we are not just receivers of His great love for us, but that we also begin to mature into vessels He can use to share His love to others.

As we start believing in and receiving God's love and understanding that there is nothing we can or can't do to change His love for us, it becomes much easier to start believing other things that He says to us in His Word and in His present-day and personal words. By His Word, we can know with a certainty that our God loves us unconditionally and has made a way for us through Jesus to succeed in Him. Regardless of what those around us say, regardless of what the devil—the

enemy of our soul—says, and regardless of what even our family might say, God says in His Word that He loves us; therefore, we are loved!

As we start growing in faith by hearing and believing what God says, an excitement and a hunger will also grow within us for more truth, more fellowship and intimacy with God that develops out of our time spent with Him in His words to us.

We want to recommend to you an important key that Pastor Dave taught over and over again through the years: that you make a practice of praying in tongues quietly under your breath—softly enough that you don't distract yourself—as you read and meditate on the Word and God's words to you.

This practice allows the Holy Spirit to co-labor with our spirit in opening up the eyes of our understanding to the Word and revealing the truths God is sharing with us and wanting to minister to us personally. Coupling His words with praying in tongues is a wonderful way to not only spend time feeding our spirit with God's eternal truths, but we will also be giving the Holy Spirit opportunity to pray out the Father's perfect plans for our life as we pray in the supernatural language of tongues—the perfect prayer created by God to be answered by God. Hallelujah!

God loves you, we love you, and we pray you know how absolutely free and loved you are through your fellowship with the Father.
