Dear Friend,

Last month, we shared from Scripture how **God is love** (First John 4:8), and because He is love, we cannot earn or invalidate His unending love for us. His love is unchanging and eternal. We can choose not to believe or accept His love, but we cannot change the fact that Love is who God is, and that He loves us unconditionally.

You see, step one for us as born-again sons and daughters of God is fellowshiping with Him, for as we develop our relationship with God by spending time with Him, talking to Him, reading the Word and praying in the spirit, worshiping and praising Him, and speaking the truths in His Word and the present-day words He speaks to us, we grow in the understanding of our life in Him, and His love for us becomes a living truth within us. Our times of fellowship with God become the foundation of our life in Him upon which we grow spiritually, gaining understanding of His thoughts toward us and about who we are in Christ Jesus. It is through fellowship with God that we receive His love for us and grow in our love for Him as our Heavenly Father.

Sometimes circumstances or our own emotions try to tell us that God does not want us, that He sees us as failures, and His thoughts toward us are bad. But the Word says in Jeremiah 29:11: **For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and NOT OF EVIL, to give you an expected end.** The Amplified version translates this verse as: **For I know the plans *and* thoughts that I have for you,' says the LORD, 'plans for peace *and* well-being and NOT FOR DISASTER, to give you A FUTURE AND A HOPE.** Regardless of what we do or don't do, God's love, thoughts, and plans for us are always for our good. But for us to receive the goodness He has for each one of us, we need to come to Him in fellowship and keep coming to Him to spend time with Him in His truth and Presence even when our emotions and thoughts try to push us away from Him.

Our Father knew before we were even born that we would need a Savior to rescue us from darkness and an eternity spent separated from Him. Out of His great love for us, He made a way of restoration through Jesus to bring us back to Himself. He gave us the perfect and righteous standing of His Firstborn Son, which allows us direct access to His Presence—our Father, the Almighty God—anytime we choose. We can come to Him in fellowship anytime we want to, just because we want to, and He is always ready and willing and pleased to reveal to us aspects of Himself as our Father. In fact, it is in fellowship with Him in His Presence that the Holy Spirit helps us grow in our faith and believing in who we are in God and in His promises and plans for us. In God's Presence is where change takes place in our life—where we are changed day by day into the image of Jesus.

Hebrews 4:16 says that in times of difficulty, we still have this same, free access to our Heavenly Father: **Let us therefore come boldly** [fearlessly, confidently, without shame] **unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.** There is nothing that we need to succeed, to overcome in this life that is not available in our Father's Presence. Jesus' death and

resurrection made sure that our Father is as available to us as He was to Jesus when He was on the earth. Our part is to come and spend time with Him, and like any relationship, the more time we spend with Him, the more we will get to know who He is, the more we will understand how much He really loves us and who we are in Christ Jesus.

The enemy would love for us to spend our life trapped in condemnation, too ashamed by our mistakes and failures to come to God immediately for forgiveness and restoration. Thankfully, the Word says in First John 1:9: **If we confess our sins, he [our Heavenly Father] is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.** We do not have to be beaten down by the devil's condemnation. If we sin, if we walk out of alignment with God's nature within us, if we disobey what His Word says, **IMMEDIATELY** we can run straight into our Father's Presence with a repentant heart, without fear or shame, and we can ask for His forgiveness, and the blood of Jesus will cleanse us from **ALL** unrighteousness. His love makes it possible for us to continue to walk righteously and boldly before Him because He provides mercy and grace in our times of need.

There is great peace available to us in knowing that the Creator of all creation loves us so much that He made us—made you—His child, His family. The Apostle Paul says it best in Romans 8:38,39:

For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

The plans our Father has for each of us are good. And He doesn't see these plans as an option but as who we are in Him. He desires that we all grow up in Him into who we are in Christ. As we redeem the time available to us by allowing the Lord to help us prioritize our daily fellowship with Him, He will faithfully equip every one of us for that which He purposed in His heart at each of our beginnings. Good are the Father's plans for us, and we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works. Amen.

We encourage you to read and meditate on the present-day speaking included in this letter, spending time speaking them aloud, hearing the Lord speaking them to your heart, knowing they are your Father's words shared directly from His heart to yours. May His grace, truth, and love strengthen your heart as you fellowship with Him. God bless you!

Come Just as You Are
