I Am Calling You Forward—Stir Up What Is Inside of You

Many of My children have built blocks in their life to stand on, but it's their own strength, their own power, and they feel safe, but because they won't go into this place of relying on Me for everything, of knowing Me as their Father, their Provider, the One who leads their steps, I have been limited to what I can do [in their lives]. You Never Disqualified Yourself in My Eyes

Some of you look at the battle you are going through, and this is a battle of holiness, a battle of struggle over longterm things that you have tried to change and tried to quit, and He says to you, Don't give up.
