

Jesus Bore Our Sin And Our Sickness

Isa 53:4 Surely^{H403} he^{H1931} hath borne^{H5375} our griefs,^{H2483} and carried^{H5445} our sorrows:^{H4341} yet we^{H587} did esteem^{H2803} him stricken,^{H5060} smitten^{H5221} of God,^{H430} and afflicted.^{H6031}

hath borne H5375 – nasa – to lift, to carry away
and carried H5445 – sabal – to bear, to carry away

Isa 53:11 He shall see^{H7200} of the travail^{H4480 H5999} of his soul,^{H5315} *and* shall be satisfied:^{H7646} by his knowledge^{H1847} shall my righteous^{H6662} servant^{H5650} justify^{H6663} many;^{H7227} for he^{H1931} shall bear^{H5445} their iniquities.^{H5771}

away H5445 – sabal – to bear, to carry away

Jesus bore our sins and took the punishment for them so we could be free of sin. Using the very same Hebrew word, He bore our sickness and carried our pain so we could be healed. The same word ... sabal ... whatever he did with our iniquities is what he did with our sicknesses.

Isa 53:12 Therefore^{H3651} will I divide^{H2505} him *a portion* with the great,^{H7227} and he shall divide^{H2505} the spoil^{H7998} with^{H854} the strong;^{H6099} because^{H8478 H834} he hath poured out^{H6168} his soul^{H5315} unto death:^{H4194} and he^{H1931} was numbered^{H4487} with^{H854} the transgressors;^{H6586} and he bare^{H5375} the sin^{H2399} of many,^{H7227} and made intercession^{H6293} for the transgressors.^{H6586}

H5375 – nasa – he bare the sin of many. Same Hebrew word used to say He bare our sicknesses.

Jesus either did both or He did neither. He bore them both or He bore neither of them. He did the same with sicknesses and diseases that He did with the sins. IT IS ILLEGAL TO SAY HE BORE OUR SIN BUT NOT OUR SICKNESSES, ACCORDING TO THE WORD OF GOD!

Holy Spirit interpretation of Isaiah 53:4

Mat 8:16-17 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with *his* word, and healed all that were sick: (17) That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, **Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.**

Grief And Sorrows = Sickness And Pains

Grief – H2483 – choliy – disease, grief, sickness

[Note: The following is a list of the verses translating the Hebrew word as sickness or disease.]

Deu 7:15 And the LORD^{H3068} will take away^{H5493} from^{H4480} thee all^{H3605} sickness,^{H2483} and will put^{H7760} none^{H3605 H3808} of the evil^{H7451} diseases^{H4064} of Egypt,^{H4714} which^{H834} thou knowest,^{H3045} upon thee; but will lay^{H5414} them upon all^{H3605} *them* that hate^{H8130} thee.

Deu 28:59 Then the LORD^{H3068} will make^(H853) thy plagues^{H4347} wonderful,^{H6381} and the plagues^{H4347} of thy seed,^{H2233} *even* great^{H1419} plagues,^{H4347} and of long continuance,^{H539} and sore^{H7451} sicknesses,^{H2483} and of long continuance.^{H539}

Deu 28:61 Also^{H1571} every^{H3605} sickness,^{H2483} and every^{H3605} plague,^{H4347} which^{H834} is not^{H3808} written^{H3789} in the book^{H5612} of this^{H2063} law,^{H8451} them will the LORD^{H3068} bring^{H5927} upon^{H5921} thee, until^{H5704} thou be destroyed.^{H8045}

1Ki 17:17 And it came to pass^{H1961} after^{H310} these^{H428} things,^{H1697} *that* the son^{H1121} of the woman,^{H802} the mistress^{H1172} of the house,^{H1004} fell sick;^{H2470} and his sickness^{H2483} was^{H1961} so^{H3966} sore,^{H2389} that^{H5704 H834} there was no^{H3808} breath^{H5397} left^{H3498} in him.

2Ki 1:2 And Ahaziah^{H274} fell down^{H5307} through^{H1157} a lattice^{H7639} in his upper chamber^{H5944} that^{H834} was in Samaria,^{H8111} and was sick;^{H2470} and he sent^{H7971} messengers,^{H4397} and said^{H559} unto^{H413} them, Go,^{H1980} enquire^{H1875} of Baalzebub^{H1176} the god^{H430} of Ekron^{H6138} whether^{H518} I shall recover^{H2421} of this disease.^{H4480 H2483}

2Ki 8:8 And the king^{H4428} said^{H559} unto^{H413} Hazael,^{H2371} Take^{H3947} a present^{H4503} in thine hand,^{H3027} and go,^{H1980} meet^{H7122} the man^{H376} of God,^{H430} and enquire^{H1875 (H853)} of the LORD^{H3068} by^{H4480 H854} him, saying,^{H559} Shall I recover^{H2421} of this disease?^{H4480 H2483} H2088

2Ki 8:9 So Hazael^{H2371} went^{H1980} to meet^{H7122} him, and took^{H3947} a present^{H4503} with^{H3027} him, even of every^{H3605} good thing^{H2898} of Damascus,^{H1834} forty^{H705} camels^{H1581} burden,^{H4853} and came^{H935} and stood^{H5975} before^{H6440} him, and said,^{H559} Thy son^{H1121}

Benhadad^{H1130} king^{H4428} of Syria^{H758} hath sent^{H7971} me to^{H413} thee, saying,^{H559} Shall I recover^{H2421} of this disease?^{H4480 H2483 H2088}

2Ki 13:14 Now Elisha^{H477} was fallen sick^{H2470} of^{H854} his sickness^{H2483} whereof^{H834} he died.^{H4191} And Joash^{H3101} the king^{H4428} of Israel^{H3478} came down^{H3381} unto^{H413} him, and wept^{H1058} over^{H5921} his face,^{H6440} and said,^{H559} O my father,^{H1} my father,^{H1} the chariot^{H7393} of Israel,^{H3478} and the horsemen^{H6571} thereof.

2Ch 16:12 And Asa^{H609} in the thirty^{H7970} and ninth^{H8672} year^{H8141} of his reign^{H4438} was diseased^{H2456} in his feet,^{H7272} until^{H5704} his disease^{H2483} was exceeding^{H4605} great: yet^{H1571} in his disease^{H2483} he sought^{H1875} not^{H3808 (H853)} to the LORD,^{H3068} but^{H3588} to the physicians.^{H7495}

2Ch 21:15 And thou^{H859} shalt have great^{H7227} sickness^{H2483} by disease^{H4245} of thy bowels,^{H4578} until^{H5704} thy bowels^{H4578} fall out^{H3318} by reason of^{H4480} the sickness^{H2483} day^{H3117} by^{H5921} day.^{H3117}

2Ch 21:18 And after^{H310} all^{H3605} this^{H2063} the LORD^{H3068} smote^{H5062} him in his bowels^{H4578} with an incurable^{H369 H4832} disease.^{H2483}

2Ch 21:19 And it came to pass,^{H1961} that in process of time,^{H3117 H4480 H3117} after the end^{H6256 H3318 H7093} of two^{H8147} years,^{H3117} his bowels^{H4578} fell out^{H3318} by reason of^{H5973} his sickness:^{H2483} so he died^{H4191} of sore^{H7451} diseases.^{H8463} And his people^{H5971} made^{H6213} no^{H3808} burning^{H8316} for him, like the burning^{H8316} of his fathers.^{H1}

Psa 41:3 The LORD^{H3068} will strengthen^{H5582} him upon^{H5921} the bed^{H6210} of languishing:^{H1741} thou wilt make^{H2015} all^{H3605} his bed^{H4904} in his sickness.^{H2483}

Ecc 5:17 All^{H3605} his days^{H3117} also^{H1571} he eateth^{H398} in darkness,^{H2822} and he hath much^{H7235} sorrow^{H3707} and wrath^{H7110} with his sickness.^{H2483}

Ecc 6:2 A man^{H376} to whom^{H834} God^{H430} hath given^{H5414} riches,^{H6239} wealth,^{H5233} and honour,^{H3519} so that he wanteth^{H2638} nothing^{H369} for his soul^{H5315} of all^{H4480 H3605} that^{H834} he desireth,^{H183} yet God^{H430} giveth him not power^{H7980 H3808} to eat^{H398} thereof,^{H4480} but^{H3588} a stranger^{H376 H5237} eateth^{H398} it: this^{H2088} is vanity,^{H1892} and it^{H1931} is an evil^{H7451} disease.^{H2483}

Isa 1:5 Why^{H5921 H4100} should ye be stricken^{H5221} any more?^{H5750} ye will revolt^{H5627} more and more:^{H3254} the whole^{H3605} head^{H7218} is sick,^{H2483} and the whole^{H3605} heart^{H3824} faint.^{H1742}

Isa 38:9 The writing^{H4385} of Hezekiah^{H2396} king^{H4428} of Judah,^{H3063} when he had been sick,^{H2470} and was recovered^{H2421} of his sickness:^{H4480} **H2483**

Hos 5:13 When Ephraim^{H669} saw^{H7200 (H853)} his sickness,^{H2483} and Judah^{H3063} saw^(H853) his wound,^{H4205} then went^{H1980} Ephraim^{H669} to^{H413} the Assyrian,^{H804} and sent^{H7971} to^{H413} king^{H4428} Jareb:^{H3377} yet could^{H3201} he^{H1931} not^{H3808} heal^{H7495} you, nor^{H3808} cure^{H1455 H4480} you of your wound.^{H4205}

Sorrows – H4341 – grief, pain sorrow

[Note: This word is often translated grief or sorrow, but it is sometimes translated as pain.]

Job 33:19 He is chastened^{H3198} also with pain^{H4341} upon^{H5921} his bed,^{H4904} and the multitude^{H7230} of his bones^{H6106} with strong^{H386} *pain*:

Jer 51:8 Babylon^{H894} is suddenly^{H6597} fallen^{H5307} and destroyed:^{H7665} howl^{H3213} for^{H5921} her; take^{H3947} balm^{H6875} for her pain,^{H4341} if so be^{H194} she may be healed.^{H7495}
