### PT210829A – Aug 29, 2021 I Am Developing a Flow of My Spirit

I am developing a flow of the Spirit in this place. I am developing within you as a body an anointing, and I am teaching you and training you how to recognize when I am flowing and moving. And you will find times in a service when I will move not just through the preacher, but I will begin to move through the crowd and through the congregation by My Spirit in such a way that man is not acknowledged for what he has, but I am acknowledged for what I bring into the place.

You will see that in this place I have already laid a foundation, and I have been developing in you the ability to flow with Me. So do not be afraid when My Spirit comes and moves among you. Do not wait upon the ministry of the man or woman from the pulpit, but just enter in and receive from the flow of My Spirit as I come. For I will bring healing and restoration and freedom.

And there are some who have cried out for many years and have wondered, “When will I be touched? When will this happen?” And they have looked for a gift and for a move of My Spirit to come. They have waited for the laying on of hands. They have wanted many different things, but I am sending many of them to this place, and when they walk in the door, they will be touched by My Spirit. They will be touched by a move of grace, and it will happen because you have learned how to flow with Me.

It will happen not because a minister is preaching or bringing the anointing but because you as a congregation will bring that anointing into this place. I am moving through My people. I am bringing into this house [church] a resident anointing.

It is a time for you to be in church. It is a time for you to be in this place. For many have said “I can pray at home and I can seek the Lord in my own time, and I can get into His Presence,” and yes, it is true, but I am saying to you that I am bringing a corporate anointing into this place. And I need the authority and grace that I put in the lives of My people to come together and [to] allow a river to flow that will reach one another, yes, and from there will reach even the world.

**John 14:26** But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

**John 16:7** Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

### PT210829B – Aug 29, 2021 There Has to Be a Healing and a Restoration

He wants to heal us. We've endured a long time. There's been a lot of pain, a lot of hurt, a lot of heartache. And in order to fight the war, many times we had to ignore those

things, and we had to press in by His Spirit and push past those things. But He said the scars and the hurt, it never really went away. We just pushed past it.

He is saying He wants to heal those hurts. He is beginning something that is going to be restoration. He is beginning to heal some hurts of the past, and we will go through a season—maybe seasons—of healing and restoration, because He is bringing forth an army and we will see miracles outside of this place. But to see the miracles to those that are outside, there has to be a healing and a restoration inside.

And He wants as much [for] us to walk in the fullness of God as He wants to flow that fullness through us. And sometimes we can be so consumed in [desires for] seeing revival and wanting revival and seeing the miracles flow through us that we forget to receive it for ourselves. We don't realize—we look past all of the hurts, all of the inabilities, all of the problems that we have and we say "Well, it's worth it for the Gospel." But God says you don't have to live with it.

You don't have to carry the pain, you don't have to carry the hurt, you don't have to carry the inabilities any longer. Because I love you as much as I love the people I am trying to reach through you.

### **PT210829E – Aug 29, 2021 Make Room for the Things of God**

### **PT210829F – Aug 29, 2021** **I Am Making Room for More of Me**

I am bringing a correction to those who will hear and those who will receive of My Spirit. It is not a correction by word nor by man, but it is a correction by My Spirit that I am bringing to those who will listen and receive from Me, because there are adjustments that must be made in the hearts of man in order for Me to advance this body into what I have planned.

So I am saying to you this day: Listen. Listen in your spirit. Listen in the private times and places, and open up those areas in your heart that you have kept private and said, "These are things that I do. This is my time. These are the things that God doesn't bother me about."

He says, Bring those things to Me, for some have said, "Yeah, for that person they must stop doing that, and for this person they must do that." But I say for each and every one, I am making adjustments and changing things within you. So do not have the attitude that I would not touch these things in your life, but bring them to Me.

I am not going to force your hand. I am not going to demand those things from you, but I am asking you to bring them freely to Me—the things in your life that you own, the time that you own, the pleasures and entertainment that you own. If you will bring that to Me, let Me judge it and allow Me to say, continue in this or do not continue in this.

In order to advance in My Spirit, there is a responsibility and a requirement that I am bringing upon those who want to go. And in this level, it is going to mean bringing everything to Me. Those places in the soul that you thought were just fun and enjoyable and have been—I want that. Bring it to Me.

I will give you fun, I will give you joy. I will give you peace. But I am requiring all of you, all of you. Do not have the attitude, "He wouldn't take this away from me," because number one, I am not taking it from you. I am making room for more of Me.
